Information for Performing Groups

It is noisy in the Rotunda during the performances. If you have a small group, you will need to ensure they are heard by selecting pieces that can be performed in a loud manner; pianissimo does not work! Consider combining several groups if you have a small group. A piano is usually available. We do have a sound system and can play CDs. Groups performing between 12:00 and 1:00 are expected to sing in the Finale. You will receive information about the piece selected for the finale.

Information about Performing on the South Steps: Depending on the weather, you may or may not have a large audience. Be prepared for cold weather. The State Facilities and Management people will not set up the equipment if it is raining. Other than that, it will be up to the director to decide if the weather is acceptable for the performance.
2. Chairs for the audience are set up on the lawn; performances take place on the steps.
